Celebration of Life for The Rev. Robert Diehl: The celebration will be on Saturday, June 22nd., at Grace Church, Port Huron at 11:00 a.m. Bob was active as a lay person in the Diocese of Michigan and then Eastern Michigan and a huge supporter of Camp Chickagami. He was ordained as a priest in the St. Paul's team ministry in 2006 and served St. Paul's until it joined with Grace in 2015. Bob died on Dec. 20, 2018 after a long illness.
